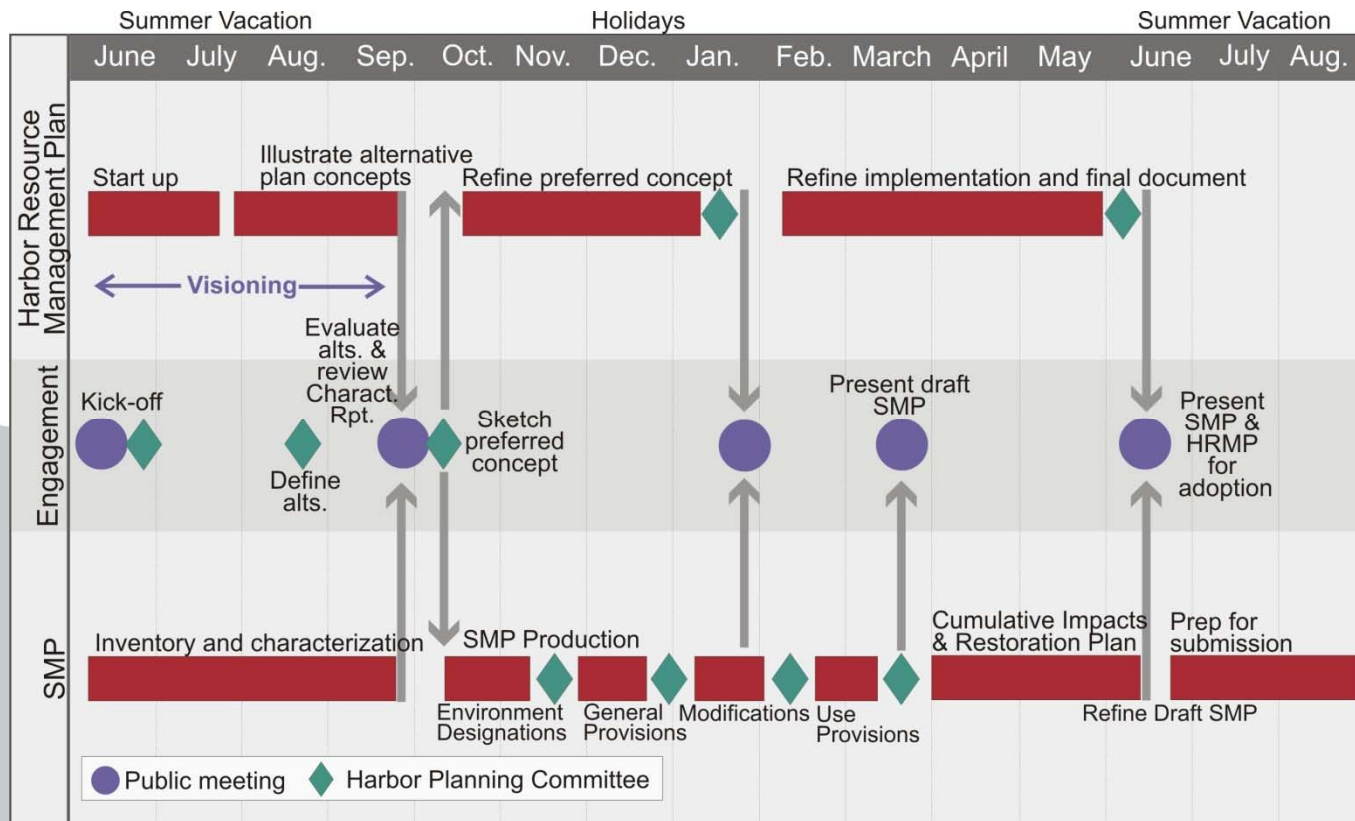
How the projects work together to support specific actions
